## Why does Horn of Africa exist?

A third of those living in the world today (over 7,000 people groups) have not heard the gospel in a way that they can understand. Because of this, Jesus is not being worshipped by every tongue, language, tribe, and nation. Many of these people groups live in the Horn of Africa, North Africa, and the Middle East.

Since the beginning of Horn of Africa in 2002, workers have been using the disciple making movement (DMM) strategy to see disciples who make disciples, churches that plant churches, and movements which birth movements.

Horn of Africa has helped to pioneer the beginning of movements in many of these unreached people groups.

#### Vision

To plant Christ-honoring, culture-affirming churches among least-reached people groups of the Horn of Africa and beyond.

Use Disciple Making Movement (DMM) strategies to bring the good news to every people group in the Horn of Africa, North Africa, and the Middle East.
