Why does Horn of Africa exist?

A third of those living in the world today (over 7,000 people groups) have not heard the gospel in a way that they can understand. Because of this, Jesus is not being worshipped by every tongue, language, tribe, and nation. Many of these people groups live in the Horn of Africa, North Africa, West Africa, the Middle East, and Asia.

Since the beginning of Horn of Africa in 2002, workers have been using the disciple making movement (DMM) strategy to see disciples who make disciples, churches that plant churches, and movements which birth movements.

Horn of Africa has helped to pioneer the beginning of movements in many of these unreached people groups.

Vision

to establish viable, reproducible, and culturally relevant churches in order to see Jesus Christ worshipped in every language and people group in the Horn of Africa and beyond.
